#### Commuter Student Resource Center

The Commuter Student Resource Center makes your day as a commuter student run more smoothly. The center provides a comfortable and friendly environment in Student Center East where commuters can go to relax between classes or to study. It has a lounge space, study spaces, kitchen, lockers, showers, a multipurpose room and lactation rooms. The staff can also provide information to commuter students on housing and transportation resources.

#### **Project Oasis**

The **Project Oasis program** provides places to interact, study and collaborate between classes. More than two dozen comfortable and supportive learning spaces have been created with attention to lighting, acoustics and ergonomics. #### **Special interest housing**

You can apply to live in special interest communities, sharing living space with students who have similar interests. Some communities are academic, where students share major or career goals—while others, like the health and fitness community, focus on a non-academic interest. Each community has a peer-mentor who guides resident students to success in and out of the classroom. Faculty-in-Residence are designated to work with special interest communities.


